2017 Burn Permits

As you know LSW is now the sole provider of fire and rescue services for Victor Township. There are two changes that you need to be aware of regarding burn permits. **One**, ALL burn permits are now issued on an annual basis. **Two**, you will only need a single burn permit for your recreational and brush fires. To obtain a burn permit for 2017 please call the LSW office at [517-651-2638](tel:517-651-2638), after January 1st 2017. Leave your name, address and phone number and someone will call you back. Please note that you do not have a valid burn permit until you receive a call back from LSW. If you don't have a burn permit and you start a fire that LSW has to respond to, you may be violating a Victor Township ordinance.

Payments must be in the office by 5:00 p.m. on the due date or penalty and interest will be charged. If you decide to pay in person the office is open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday 1:00 to 4:30 and 2:00 to 4:30 on Wednesday. **Make checks payable to Victor Township Treasurer.** If you are paying with cash please have exact change. **We do not keep cash on hand in the office.**

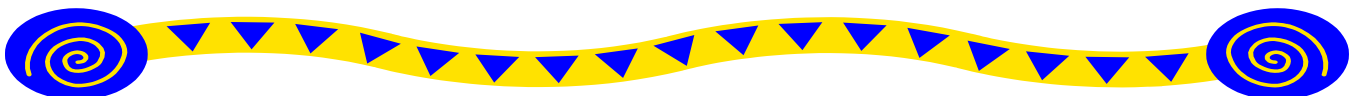
*** NEW * Treasurer Office Hours**
