Victor Township will have a new playground installed this summer! The playground will be located behind the Victor Township Hall between the soccer fields. Toddler swings and whirlwind spinner seats will accompany the main structure. The area includes engineered wood fiber safety surfacing with ADA accessible concrete walkways and ramps. Absent Voting for Everyone!

The passing of Proposal 18-3 makes it possible for all registered voters to vote absent ballot.

Your request for an absent voter ballot **must be in writing** and must be submitted to your township clerk. You must request an absent voter ballot by mailing the application, letter, a postcard, or a pre-printed application form obtained from your local clerk's office or Secretary of State office. Requests to have an absent voter ballot mailed to you must be received by your clerk no later than 5 p.m. the Friday before the election.

Once your request is received by the local clerk, your signature on the request will be checked against your voter registration record before a ballot is issued. You must be a registered voter to receive an absent voter ballot. Requests for absent voter ballots are processed immediately. Absent voter ballots may be issued to you at your home address or any address outside of your city or township of residence.
