CodeRED

Now Available on Your iOS or Android Device

If you live in Clinton County and have a landline phone, you already may be in the CodeRed system. You will receive a call on your landline phone when there is an emergency in your area. To be certain, make sure to enroll your numbers.

You can also get CodeRED on your iOS or Android device. Download the free app and be notified of emergencies in the area – wherever you are.

To get CodeRED messages on your cell phone, by text message or by email, you can enter that information by going to the website: www.clinton-county.org

Your contact information will never be given out to anyone else, and will only be used for an emergency.

Smart911 Keep Your Loved Ones Safe!

Smart911 is free, private, secure and protects over 31 million people nationwide. (Continued on next page)

Smart911 (continued)

Sign up for Smart911 and create a secure Safety Profile for your household.

If you ever call 9-1-1 the call taker can see the emergency information you want them to see.

Address Details -- First responders can help you faster when you provide address details about your home.

Family – If any member of your household calls 9-1-1, information about your entire family will be available including emergency contacts.

Medical Information – Avoid dangerous drug interactions or allergic reactions by listing your medications and conditions.

Animals – Keep all members of your household safe by including pets, livestock or service animals that responders need to be aware of.

Provide as much or as little information as you want. Smart911 only asks for information that is relevant to aid emergency response. Your information is only available to 9-1-1 call takers and first responders.
