## IMPORTANT SUMMERTAX INFORMATION



Payments can be made by mail, in person or in the drop box outside of the Victor Township Hall. You are encouraged to pay your property taxes by mail; however, the postmark dates DO NOT serve as payment dates. **Payments must be in the office by 5:00 p.m. on the due date or penalty and interest will be charged.** Feel free to email the Treasurer or Deputy Treasurer at [treasurer@victortwp.org](mailto:treasurer@victortwp.org) with any questions or concerns, or you can call the office at 517-651-2094. If you decide to pay in person the office is open Monday and Thursday 1:00 to 4:30. **Make checks payable to Victor Township Treasurer.** If you are paying with cash please have exact change. **We do not keep cash on hand in the office.** This year we are asking that you include a phone number with your payment should we need to contact you about your payment.

### Treasurer Office Hours

The Treasurer will be in the office during July, August and September to accept payments on most Tuesdays from 5:30 PM to 7:30 PM or by appointment.

**The Treasurer will also be in the office from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Friday, September 14<sup>th</sup> 2018, the day summer taxes or summer deferments are due.**

### Deferment of Summer Taxes

Applications for Deferment of Summer Taxes- Household income must not exceed \$40,000, be 62 years of age or older including surviving spouse of person who was 62 years of age or older at the time of death; Paraplegic, Quadriplegic; Eligible Serviceperson, Eligible Veteran, Eligible Widow or Widower; Blind Person; or Totally and Permanently Disabled. Form (available at the township office) must be filed by September 14<sup>th</sup> 2018.

## ELECTION INFORMATION

### Election Dates to Remember for the 2018 Michigan Elections

**July 9, 2018:** Last day to register to vote in the August primary.

**August 7, 2018:** State Primary Election. POLLS ARE OPEN 7:00 A.M. – 8:00 P.M

**Oct. 9, 2018:** Last day to register to vote in the November general election.

**November 6, 2018:** State General Election POLLS ARE OPEN 7:00 A.M. – 8:00 P.M

### Who is Eligible for an Absent Voter Ballot?

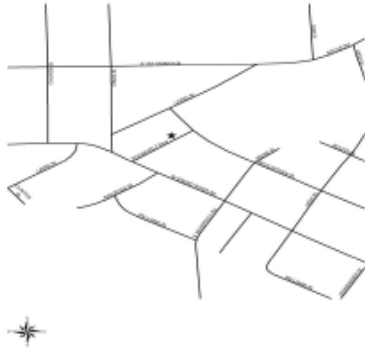
A registered voter may obtain an absent voter ballot if they are:

- Age 60 years old or older
- Unable to vote without assistance at the polls
- Expecting to be out of town on election day
- In jail awaiting arraignment or trial
- Unable to attend the polls due to religious reasons
- Appointed to work as an election inspector in a precinct outside of their precinct of residence.

### Requesting an Absent Voter Ballot

You may request an application by phone. Your request for an absent voter ballot must be in writing and can be submitted to your township clerk. Your request must include one of the six statutory reasons stated above and your signature (which is check against your voter registration record before a ballot is issued). Requests to have an absent voter ballot mailed to you must be received by your clerk no later than 2 p.m. the Saturday before the election.

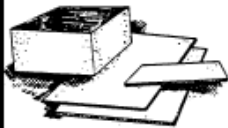
