

RESOLUTION 20170801

Be it resolved that the Victor Township Board approves the following stated ballot proposal and language for submission to Township voters at the November 7, 2017 Election as follows:

**EXTRA VOTED MILLAGE FOR VICTOR TOWNSHIP
TO EQUIP, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN EMERGENCY SERVICES**

Shall Victor Township, Clinton County, Michigan, impose an increase of up to 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per each \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution to be levied for a period of four (4) years, 2018 through 2021 inclusive, for the purpose of equipping, operating and maintaining emergency services (which may include fire protection and emergency medical services such as basic life support and advance life support), raising an estimated \$189,663.47 in the first year of such levy?


