The regular meeting of the Victor Township Board was called to order by Township Supervisor Pete Preston at 7:00 p.m.

Moved by Preston, seconded by McDonald to accept the Treasurer's report as written and place on file, subject to audit.

Adam Stacey – County Commissioner, gave Clinton County Board of Commissioners update: the County received an “unqualified” Audit opinion which is the highest opinion, 5.8 mills will be collected on the summer property tax collection. Moved by Wall, supported by McDonald to add a General Ledger Account number 101-265-964.000 to track Refund of Hall Deposits as an expense item. All in favor, motion carried.

Moved by McDonald, seconded by Wall to permit the Clerk to obtain veteran markers. All in favor, motion carried.
