Approved Minutes

The regular meeting of the Victor Township Board was called to order by Township Supervisor Pete Preston at 7:00 p.m.

Public comment: Information regarding Reed Cemetery upkeep and proposed changes were discussed. Comment suggesting that the Township should consider a single rubbish and recycling vendor for curbside pick- up.
