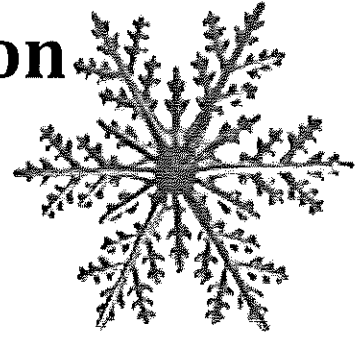


Important Tax Information



Tax payments can be made by mail, in person or left in the drop box outside of the Victor Township Hall, 6843 E. Alward Rd., Laingsburg, MI 48848. You are encouraged to pay your property taxes by mail; however, the **postmark date DOES NOT** serve as payment date.

Payments must be in the office by 5:00 p.m. on February 14, 2020 or penalty and interest will be charged. All payments being made to Victor Township need to be made by March 2, 2020 at 5:00 pm. Any payments made after March 2, 2020 must be made at the Clinton County Treasurer's office, in St. Johns.

Make checks payable to Victor Township Treasurer.

If you decide to pay in person the office is open weekdays 2:00pm to 5:00pm.

If you are paying with cash please have **exact** change. We do not keep cash on hand in the township office.

If you wish to receive a receipt you MUST include a self addressed stamped envelope.

Why is my tax bill GREEN?

A green bill means a mortgage company has requested a copy of your tax bill.

If your bill is white you are the only one receiving your tax bill.

It is always the homeowner's responsibility to pay their taxes.

Treasurer office hours

The Treasurer's office will be open MOST Tuesday evenings from 5:30pm to 7:30pm and Thursdays from 9:00am to 12:00pm in December, January and February to accept tax payments or by appointment.

The Treasurer will also be available from 9:00am to 5:00pm., to accept tax payments these days.

- December 30th 2019
- February 14th 2020
- March 2nd 2020

March 2, 2020 is the last day Victor Township can accept 2019 tax payments.
