At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Trustees of the Township of Victor, Clinton County, Michigan, held remotely utilizing the Zoom Meeting Application, Meeting ID Number _____ on the 13th day of April, 2020, at 7 o'clock in the evening:

The following preamble and Resolution were offered by Member _____ and supported by Member _____.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of this Board it is necessary to levy a tax for the purpose of defraying, in whole or in part, the cost of improvement, maintenance and repair of roadways within Victor Township; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of this Board it is necessary to renew the previously approved increase of the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed on all property within the Township for said purposes; and

WHEREAS, this Board estimates that the amount necessary to defray, in whole or in part, the cost of improvement, repair and maintenance of roadways within Victor Township could be raised by levying 1.5 mills for a period of four (4) years (2021 through 2024, both inclusive); and

WHEREAS, this Board estimates that the increase will raise, in the first year of levy, an estimated increased revenue of Two Hundred Twelve Thousand Two Hundred Fourteen Dollars and 79/100 (\$212,214.79);

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED that:

1. At an election to be held in the Township of Victor on the 3rd day of November, 2020, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., the same day as the general election, the proposition of renewing the previously voted 1.5 mill levy for a period of four (4) years, 2021 to 2024, both inclusive, for the purpose of defraying in whole or in part its share of the cost of road improvement, repair and

maintenance within Victor Township shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the Township of Victor, Clinton County, Michigan.

2. The proposition to be submitted at said election shall be stated in substantially the following form:

Shall the previously voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within the Township, as reduced by the required millage rollback which last resulted in a levy of 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) upon taxable real and personal property within the Township be renewed and levied for four (4) years, 2021 through 2024, inclusive, for funding and defraying, in whole or in part, the cost of improvement, repair and maintenance of roadways within Victor Township, which levy shall raise in the first year of the levy an estimated Two Hundred Twelve Thousand Two Hundred Fourteen Dollars and 79/100 (\$212,214.79); of revenue?
