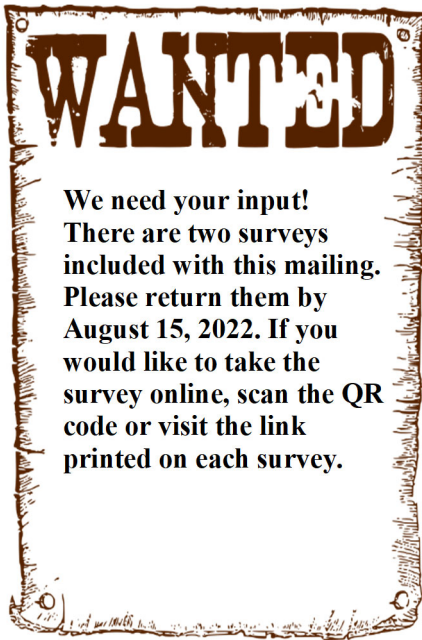
We do not accept credit cards in the office and do not have change. Please utilize the drop box located outside the hall doors for tax payments and other correspondence.

## Victor Township Accepting Online Tax Payments

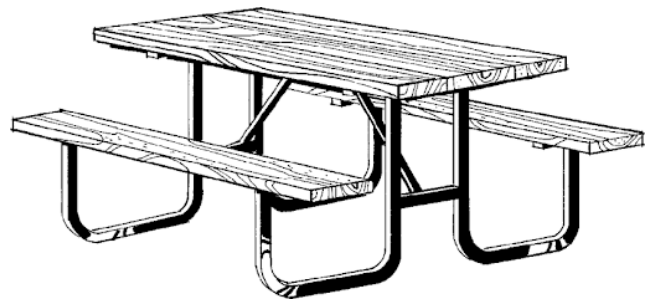

## BROADBAND UPDATE

In February, the National Telecommunications and Information Administration awarded \$277 Million in grants to expand broadband infrastructure across the country. A total of 13 grants were awarded, primarily to states and counties. Victor Township was one of 288 applicants and did not receive funding.

Clinton County has actively pursued broadband expansion. A thorough plan was developed that identifies Victor Township as one of the top priority areas. New funding opportunities are becoming available through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. Victor Township has submitted a non-binding letter of intent to partner with Clinton County to pursue these funds for broadband expansion that serves all township residents in need.



Victor Township offers free public Wi-Fi 24 hours a day seven days a week. Service will soon be available to the playground, east soccer fields and the east pavilions. The public access password is posted on the front door of the township hall.
