Food Waste Drop-off Program

Drop off food scraps at all GLR recycling drives.

- Food waste will be turned into compost at a certified facility.
- Free and open to all communities!
- Drop off food waste off in BPI-certified compostable bags, brown paper bags, wrapped in newspaper, or loose.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE SORTED, EMPTY, CLEAN, AND DRY.

<h2>Paper</h2> <p>YES: Envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards, manila folders, cardstock, shredded paper (put in a paper bag)</p> <p>NO: crayon, paint, rubber bands, tissue, adhesives (tape, labels, rubber cement)</p>	<h2>Books</h2> <p>Cardboard & Boxboard</p> <p>Denim</p> <p>Brita Products</p>
<h2>Household Batteries</h2> <p>Separate into regular (Alkaline), Lithium, rechargeable, and button (hearing aid)</p> <p>No automotive or engine batteries.</p>	<h2>Electronics</h2> <p>YES: All Electronics</p> <p>TVs and Monitors have fees. See Website.</p>
<h2>Eyeglasses & Hearing Aids (batteries removed)</h2>	<h2>Newspaper</h2>
<h2>Empty Ink Cartridges</h2>	<h2>Magazines & Catalogs</h2>
<h2>Plastics</h2> <p>*All must be rinsed, sorted, and separated by #type.</p> <p>NO: Clamshell shaped containers (used for berries/baked goods), Motor oil, automotive fluid containers</p> <p>#1 clear #1 Plastics - Clear, blue and green transparent bottles and jars only</p> <p>#2 cloudy (milk jugs, etc., with seam)</p> <p>#2 colored (with bottom seam)</p> <p>#5 plastics - tubs, lids, and cups</p> <p>Garden pots, tags and trays</p>	<h2>Tin & Metal</h2> <p>Steel food containers: (rinsed clean)</p> <p>Scrap Metal: No fuel or freon tanks</p>
<h2>Glass</h2> <p>Bottles and Jars only.</p> <p>*We currently are NOT ACCEPTING the following items:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plastics #3, #4, #6, #7 Plastic Bags Polystyrene/Styrofoam 	<h2>Aluminum</h2> <p>Foil, trays, cans (clean)</p>
	<h2>Dental Care Products</h2> <p>Toothbrushes, empty toothpaste tubes, and dental floss containers</p>
