Proposed Board Minutes of June 9, 2026

The regular board meeting of Victor Township was called to order by Clerk Prange at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, followed by a roll call of Board members in attendance. Present: Willoughby, Sayles, Pesch, Prange. Absent: Wiswasser. 10 citizens were present.

Public Comment: A resident raised a concern about the township’s parking lot’s winter drainage noting that salt runoff is flowing onto the neighboring farmland. They requested that a solution be found to address the drainage issues impacting the property.

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Willoughby, seconded by Pesch, to approve June 9, 2026, agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Sayles, seconded by Pesch, to approve May 12, 2026, regular board meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Motion by Prange, seconded by Sayles, to accept the June 2026 Treasurer's report. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Bills and Payroll: Motion by Willoughby, seconded by Sayles, to disburse May 2026 bills. (Paid June 9, 2026) Roll call: Members voting yes: Pesch, Willoughby, Sayles, Prange. Motion carried. **Checks # 12865-12896**, in the amount of **\$215,468.94**. (This includes payment to hall renovation, park project, and annual contributions.)

Motion by Willoughby, seconded by Pesch, to disburse May 2026 payroll and payroll related expenses. (Paid June 9, 2026). Roll call: Members voting yes: Willoughby, Sayles, Pesch, Prange. Motion carried. **Checks# 13374-13381** in the amount of **\$14,600.50**.

- **Planning Commission Report:** The Planning Commission presented findings regarding implementing a barking dog/noise ordinance. Many hours were devoted by board members including door to door surveys and it is their recommendation not to proceed with an ordinance of this type in the township. Discussion regarding soccer goals and request that the township purchase 2 soccer regulation nets. Motion by Sayles, seconded by Pesch to purchase the nets. Roll call: Members voting yes: Pesch, Willoughby, Sayles, Prange. Motion carried.

- **Laingsburg Public Library:** The library is continuing exploring a district-wide millage to cover the 0.3 mill required by the State of Michigan to qualify for state aid and services, hoping to place the proposal on the ballot November 3, 2026. In the meantime, the Library is open and has many programs to offer people of all ages. Correspondence: Motion by Sayles, seconded by Willoughby, to accept monthly correspondence and place it on file. Motion carried unanimously.

Unfinished Business: Discussion was held regarding replacing the existing toilets in the hall with new automatic-flush toilets as part of the building project. Motion by Prange, seconded by Sayles to add automatic-flush toilets to the hall building project. Roll call: Members voting yes: Sayles, Prange, Willoughby, Pesch. Motion carried.

New Business: On completion of the Park and Hall building projects it was discussed to have an open house for the public and have Laingsburg recyclers assist the board in a zero-waste initiative.

Motion by Willoughby, seconded by Sayles to adjourn at: 8:19 p.m. All in favor. Motion carried.
