Approved Board Minutes of July 14, 2026

The regular board meeting of Victor Township was called to order by Supervisor Wiswasser at 7:01 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, followed by a roll call of Board members in attendance. Present: Wiswasser, Willoughby, Pesch, Prange. 11 citizens were present.

Public Comment: none

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Prange, seconded by Pesch, to approve July 14, 2026, agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Pesch, seconded by Wiswasser, to approve June 9, 2026, regular board meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Motion by Prange, seconded by Pesch, to accept the July 2026 Treasurer's report. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Bills and Payroll: Motion by Willoughby, seconded by Pesch, to disburse June 2026 bills. (Paid July 14, 2026) Roll call: Members voting yes: Pesch, Willoughby, Prange, Wiswasser. Motion carried. **Checks # 12897-12917**, in the amount of **\$340,696.85**. (This includes payment to hall renovation & park project.)

Motion by Willoughby, seconded by Prange, to disburse June 2026 payroll and payroll related expenses. (Paid July 14, 2026). Roll call: Members voting yes: Willoughby, Pesch, Prange. Motion carried. **Checks # 13382-13390** in the amount of **\$16,254.70**.

Sayles entered the meeting at 7:25 p.m.

Commissioner Fickes Report:

- The Commissioners reported to the Department of Treasury Clinton County's taxable value at \$4,252,719,966
- The Opioid Settlement Advisory Steering Committee appointment recommendations first meeting will be in August.
- Work to fill Planner and Deputy Administrator positions continues.
- **Broadband** Taskforce met on June 29 and reported that the ROBIN grant funded construction will be completed this summer. Over 3200 locations will be connected to

high-speed internet. BEAD funded construction will begin later in the year which will connect another 3000+ locations.

- The Commissioners approved rezoning requests to realign county park properties.
- The commissioner meetings are recorded and can be located on the Clinton County website, clinton-county.org and on YouTube.

Planning Commission Report: The Planning Commission updated the board on the township historical group, main hall updates, and the master plan survey and updates. They will continue to review the last masterplan and add or make changes to the new plan.

Laingsburg Public Library: The library has sent the proposed library agreement to the Townships of Sciota, Woodhull, Victor, and the City of Laingsburg to create a library district. Also proposed is a district-wide millage to cover the amount required by the State of Michigan to qualify for state aid and services. They are hoping to place the proposal on the ballot November 3, 2026.

Briggs District Library: Briggs District Library offers many programs for all ages. There is a millage on the August Primary Ballot to renew the expiring millage. See briggisdistrictlibrary.org or call 989-224-4702 for more information.

Cemetery Director: The mausoleum has been taken down, and the area will be assigned to burial spaces for sale.

Maintenance and Facilities:

New bathroom accessories/hardware are being installed in the park restrooms.

- The floors and tiles have been cleaned.
- Drain issue in Parking lot is being addressed

Unfinished Business:

Park Project: Things are going as expected and are keeping to the schedule.

Hall Project: Discussion was held regarding replacing the existing drinking fountain with a high-low water cooler with bottle filler as part of the building project. Parts are unavailable for the existing fountain. Motion by Wiswasser, seconded by Sayles to add the proposed drinking fountain to the hall building project in the amount of \$3,465.00. Roll call: Members voting yes: Prange, Willoughby, Wiswasser, Sayles. Motion carried.

Laingsburg Library Agreement: Discussion regarding the submitted agreement from the Laingsburg Public Library. There were questions raised by the board regarding the wording of the agreement. Motion by Sayles and seconded by Wiswasser to table acting on this agreement until the Victor Township Board can get further clarification from our attorney and he can review the agreement with the other attorneys involved in this agreement. Motion carried unanimously.
